
HOW TO MAKE A FABRIC FACE MASK THAT SECURES BEHIND THE HEAD

Small Adult	8X8 IN (20X20 CM)	12 IN (30.5 CM)
Teen	8X8 IN (20X20 CM)	11.5 IN (29 CM)
Child	7x7 IN (18x18 CM)	11.5 IN (29 CM)

IDEAS

ADDITIONAL To help the mask mold better around your nose, you may insert a pipe cleaner, floral wire, or small piece of flat bendable metal to the top inside of the mask before forming the pleats. Sew a topstitch next to it, to hold it in place.

NOTES Please check with your local support centers before making large quanities of masks, to ensure they can accept and use them.

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
